And to Mike G. who put all the furniture together and helped rearrange Joy and Richelle's office. So much generosity!

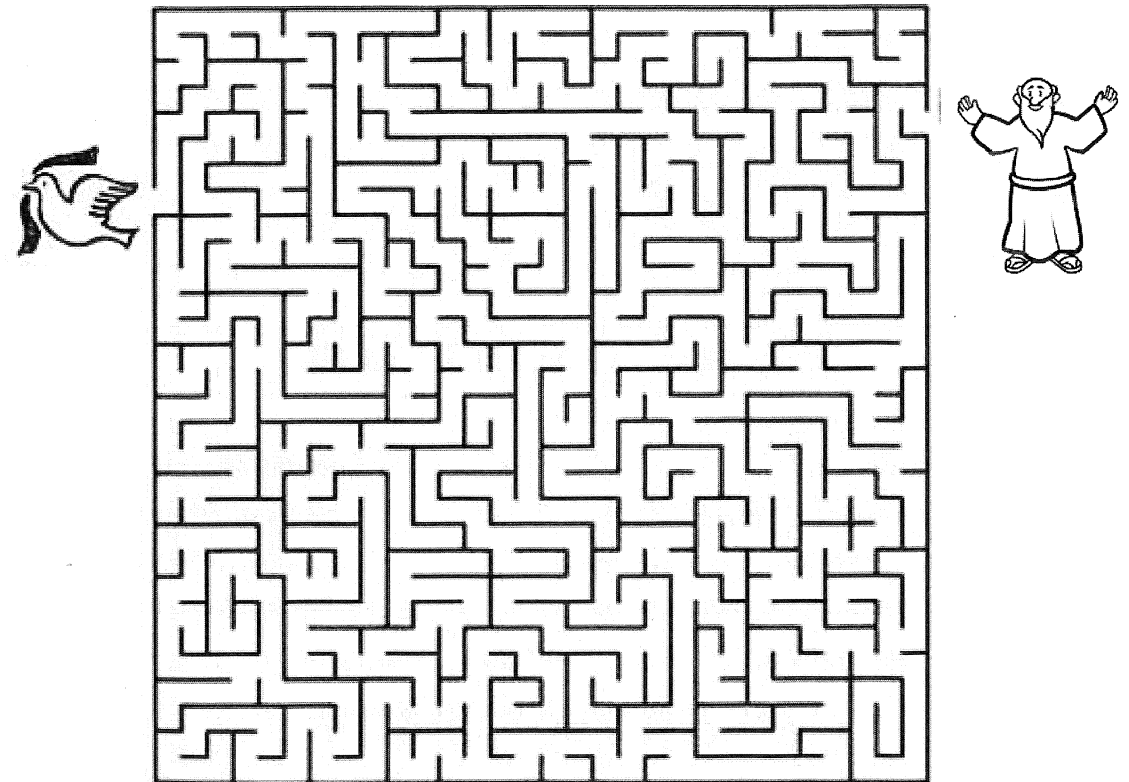
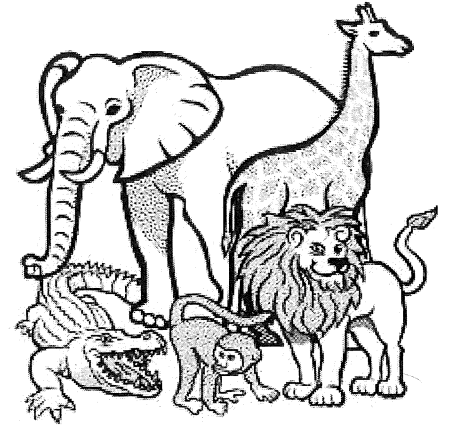
FAMILY MINISTRIES
