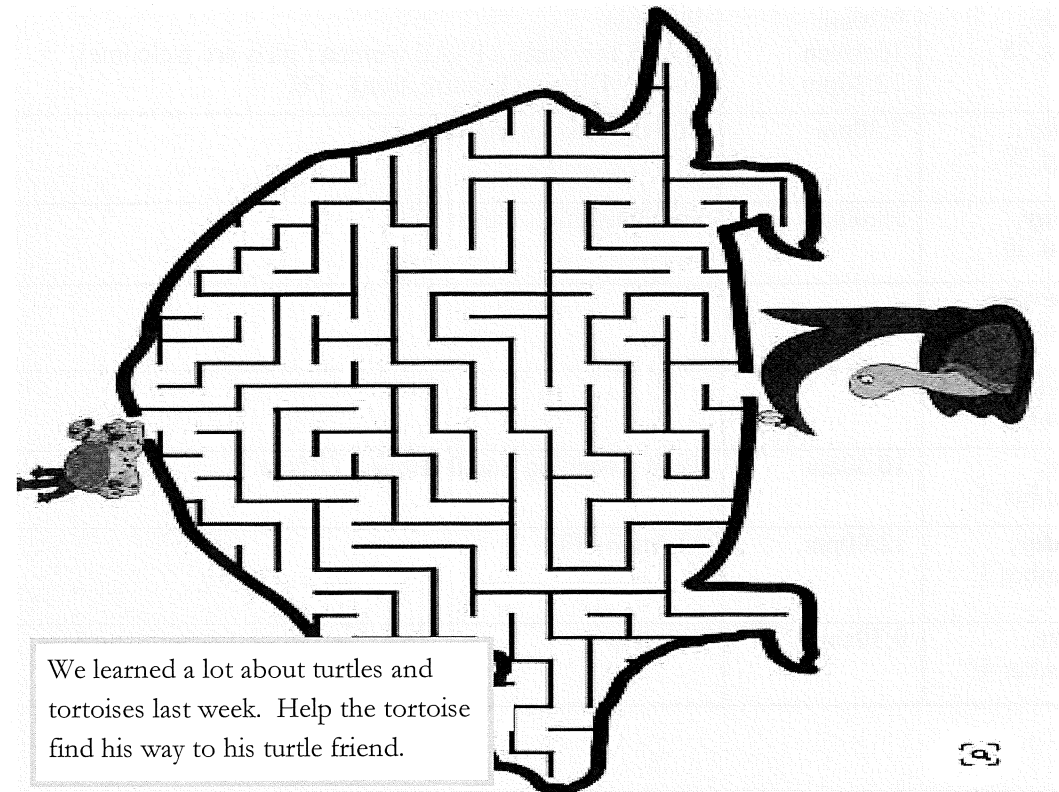
God Sightings
