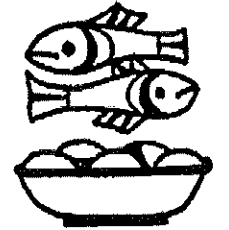

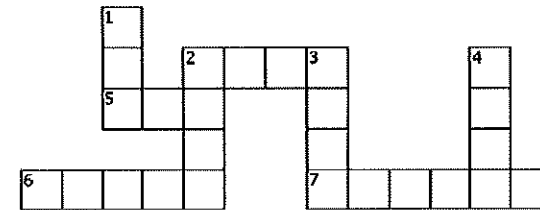
On Sunday, October 30th, the preschool – 5th graders will be dressing up in
