Please ask the servers when receiving. If you don't want to receive communion but would like a blessing, you can indicate that to the pastor.

Lent This Year

Wednesday, February 22nd (Ash Wednesday) began the season of Lent. It is our prayer that everyone here at FUMC has a meaningful Lenten season and this is what we have to offer for your spiritual development. Our theme this year (from *A Sanctified Art*) is SEEKING and is founded on questions. Many of our weekly questions feel restorative (Can these bones live?). Some feel like a charge or challenge (Who will you listen to?). Some questions are hopeful and curious (How do we begin again?). Our questions won't necessarily lead to answers, but they can help us find clarity and a new perspective. Ultimately, we pray they lead to a new beginning, a restoration, a wider grace.

Worship: Each Sunday at both 9 & 10:30 we will be exploring honest questions for deeper faith.

Devotionals: There is a beautiful devotional for you to use throughout the season. You can view this online for free (E-News link).

Prayer Cards: In addition to the devotional there are daily prayer cards that you can receive via email each morning - just inform Richelle or the Church Office and we'll sign you up.

There is a sign-up sheet in the Narthex and also via our E-News link.

UMCOR: Turkey and Syria Earthquake

Join us in prayer for the people of Turkey and Syria who have just experienced two devastating earthquakes.

The initial quake, which hit in the early morning hours, leveled buildings, killing more than 47,000 people and wounding more than 100,000 - with numbers expected to clime. News reports are already assessing the impact as the worst to hit the area in a century.

UMCOR is processing a grant to their partner in Turkey, International Blue Crescent (IBC), which has issued an appeal for emergency supplies such as tents, heaters, blankets, warm clothes, food, and first aid.
