Update from the Finance Committee

As we enter into the second half of 2023, the finance committee would like to update the congregation as to the results of our giving for the first half of the year, as well as the overall financial situation.

Thank you for your past gifts to our 50/50 campaign! In addition to the many charities and organizations we have supported, your donations to this fund over the years have made it possible for capital improvements to the church including our new parking lot! Several other smaller scale projects are also in the plans!

Our operating budget, that pays the day-to-day expenses of the church, finished the first half of the year with a deficit of \$5,000. While this is a small amount in comparison to our total budget of \$435,000, we are somewhat concerned as this is the first time in 6 years we have run a negative net amount for the first 6 months.

However, we are also encouraged, as the data indicates that this deficit will disappear as people catch up and fulfill their annual pledge in the second half of the year.

Lastly, in terms of the overall financial condition of the church, we are pleased to report that we are in a sound position. Due to grants that we were able to secure during the pandemic, and more importantly, your stewardship, we have adequate resources at present to cover temporary negative net revenues, as well as unforeseen emergent occurrences.
