Communion is celebrated once a month (usually on the first Sunday of the month) and all (including children) are welcome at the table. We use all gluten/dairy free bread. If you don't want to receive communion but would like a blessing, you can indicate that to the pastor.








UWF Book Club will meet on Monday, February 26 at the Fairport Library at 4 pm.
