Communion is celebrated once a month (usually on the first Sunday of the month) and all (including children) are welcome at the table. We use all gluten/dairy free bread. If you don't want to receive communion but would like a blessing, you can indicate that to the pastor.



We will have the special safe viewing glasses available for \$2.00 each.




All Church Winter Carnival
