Our primary work in Youth Ministry at Fairport UMC is to walk with youth in their journey to know Christ by creating an environment in which youth can experience Christian community, hear the gospel, know God's love and respond in faith by loving and serving others....for in all of this we are making disciples in Jesus Christ.

The underlying component of community is relationships. Deep relationships need time and space to develop, and form best in a space that feels safe. We each covenant to create that safe space every single time we are together and in all of our interactions—face-to-face or otherwise. Spiritual growth also happens in a climate of intimacy and emotional safety. Church is community, community is church. Each time we come together, we leave stronger and endeavor to take our best spiritual selves out into the world— our community, our families, our schools and our activities.

The Components of Youth Ministry

SUNDAY SCHOOL

The Junior High (6-8) Class and Senior High (9-12) Sunday Schools both meet on Sunday mornings at 9am. The Junior High class uses the *Colaborate* curriculum which allows students to discover more about the Old and New Testaments using proven learning methods such as problem-based learning. The Senior High class uses a mixture of curricula based on youth interests, the lectionary, and current events. A highlight on Sunday mornings is the breakfast treats that are brought in by different youth families.



YOUTH GROUP

Junior and Senior High Youth also gather on scheduled Sundays (and sometimes an occasional Saturday) for youth group. These more informal evening meetings are an important part of a youth's spiritual growth. The purpose of these group meetings is to build community, explore questions about faith and spiritual issues, as well as to relax and have a lot of FUN in Christian community.



CONFIRMATION

Those 8th graders who choose to be confirmed in the spring of the 8th grade year meet monthly with Pastor Richelle and use the *Colaborate: Methodist Confirmation* curricula. Confirmands delve into learning more about Methodist history and doctrine. Each confirmand will have a Friend in Faith (an adult member of FUMC) who will serve as a mentor to the youth. Together, they will pray, support and encourage one another on the confirmation journey. Youth confirm their baptismal vows in the Pentecost worship service in the spring and become full members of Fairport UMC.

Highlights of this trip include small group Bible study, beach swimming, ultimate Frisbee, campfires with singing, s'mores and doughboys, Saturday skits, and MORE!!!!!
