Communion is celebrated once a month (usually on the first Sunday of the month) and all (including children) are welcome at the table. We use all gluten/dairy free bread. If you don't want to receive communion but would like a blessing, you can indicate that to the pastor.

In April Outreach contributed a total of \$2,792.82 from its 50/50 fund to the following ministries:

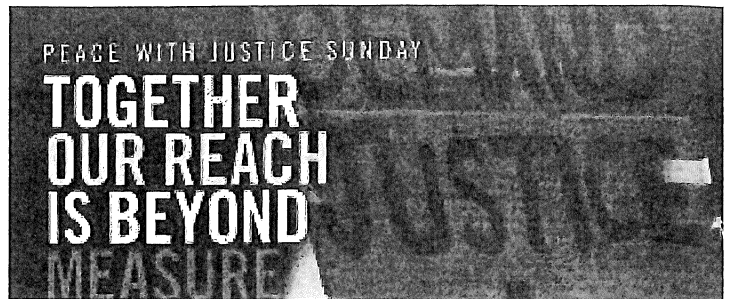
Sunday Dinner Ministry - Provides a free meal to people in need in the Fairport area on the fourth Sunday of the month.

There is no specific agenda other than connecting with others who are walking a similar road.

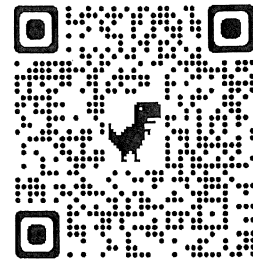
Each meeting is facilitated by Pastor Abigail Zang Hoffman, Licensed Master Social Worker (LMSW).
