

The event is free but all proceeds from the freewill offering will benefit groups at FUMC, local, and global charities.




#### Cleaning / Flood Buckets

The Apple Pie Sale happens thanks to a large number of volunteers. For this fundraiser to be a success, we need volunteers in all areas!




#### All Saints' Sunday
