And to walk humbly with the One who gave life and breath to me.

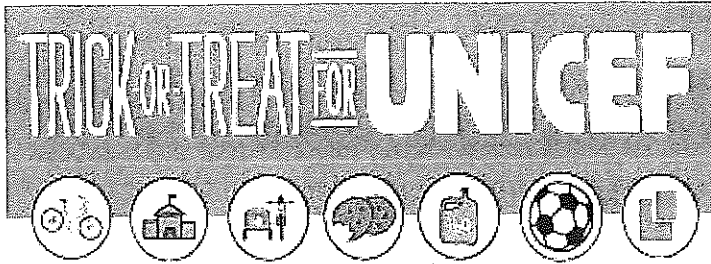
God exalts those who humbly walk with the Lord.

Take myself and I will be ever, only, all for Thee.

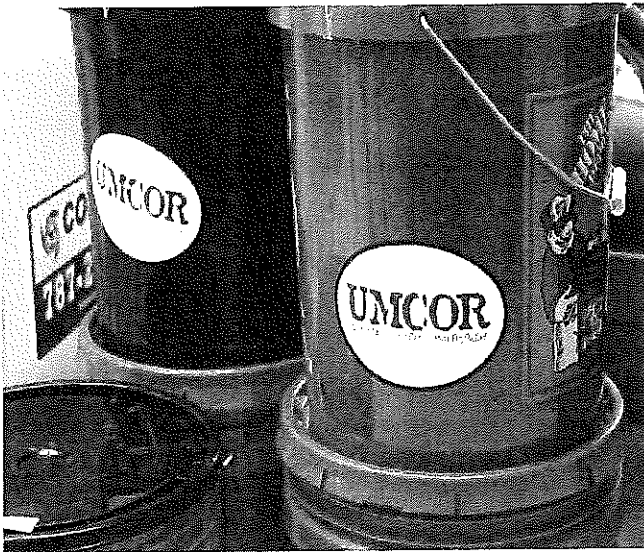

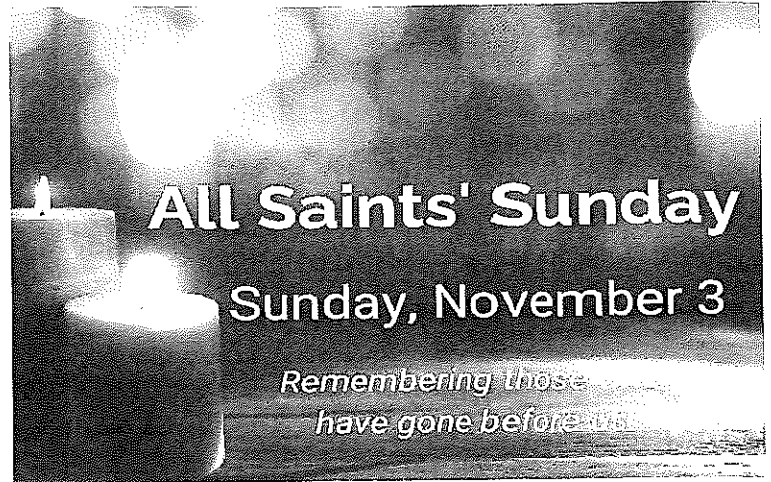

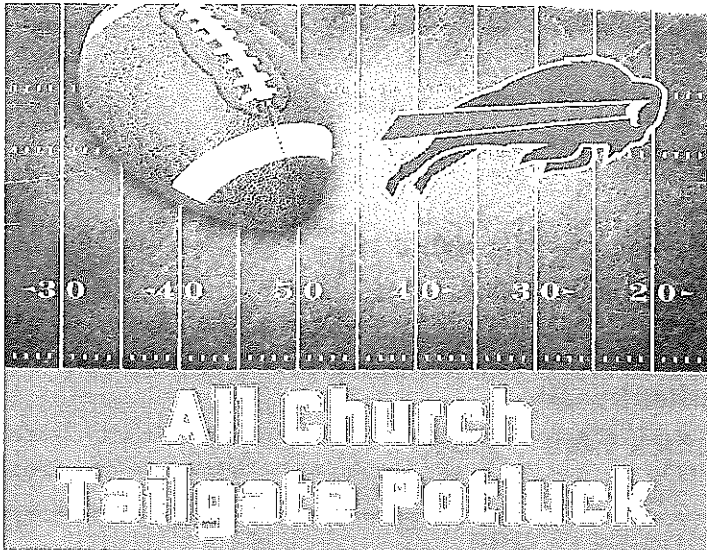
