Welcome to Fairport UMC! On communion Sundays we encourage you to retrieve you child and participate in communion together!
Note: Sunday School (Children/Youth/Adult) during the school year is at 9am.

OPEN TABLE

Communion is celebrated once a month (usually on the first Sunday of the month) and everyone (including children) is welcome at the table. We use gluten/dairy free bread and grape juice.

Oh, Lord, have mercy on me.*

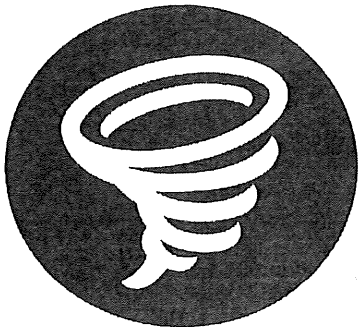

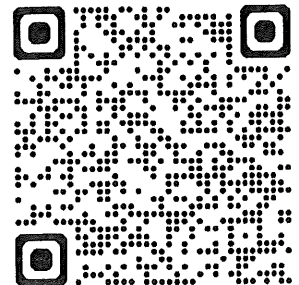

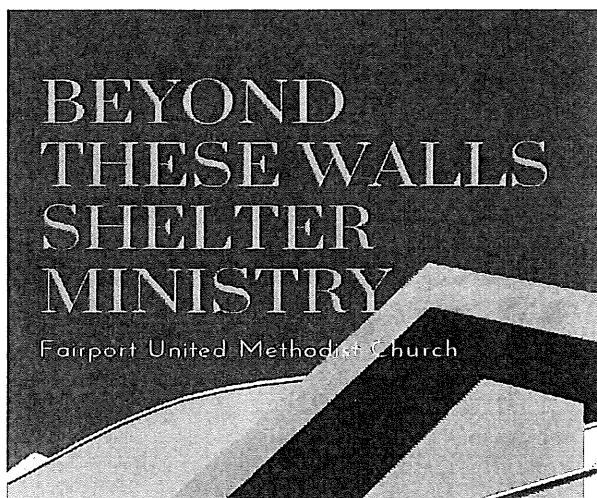
