Welcome to Fairport UMC! Communion is celebrated once a month (usually on the first Sunday of the month) and everyone (including children) is welcome at the table. We use gluten/dairy free bread and grape juice.

All Thy works shall praise Thy name in earth and sky and sea.







United Women in Faith (UWiF)


The Upper New York Conference of the United Women in Faith is holding their annual meeting "The Bold & The Brave" here at our church on Saturday, October 19th.
