Communion is celebrated once a month (usually on the first Sunday of the month) and everyone (including children) is welcome at the table. We use gluten/dairy free bread and grape juice.

We are not alone. God is with us now.

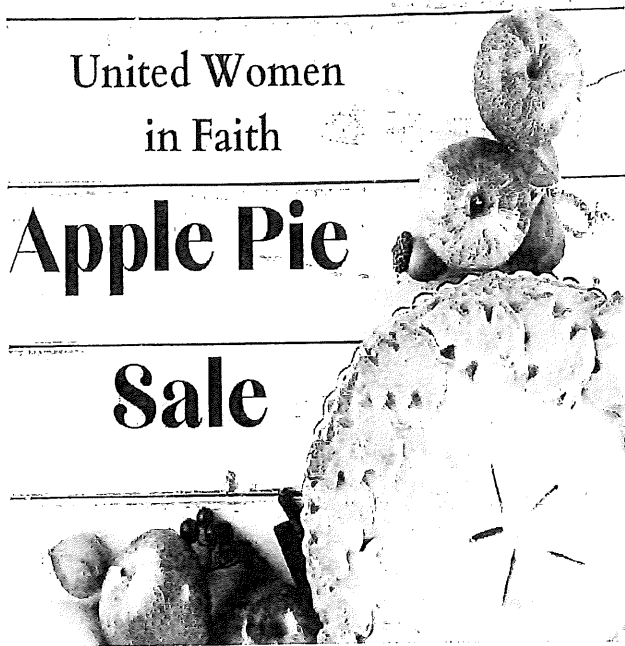

Our God is with us now.



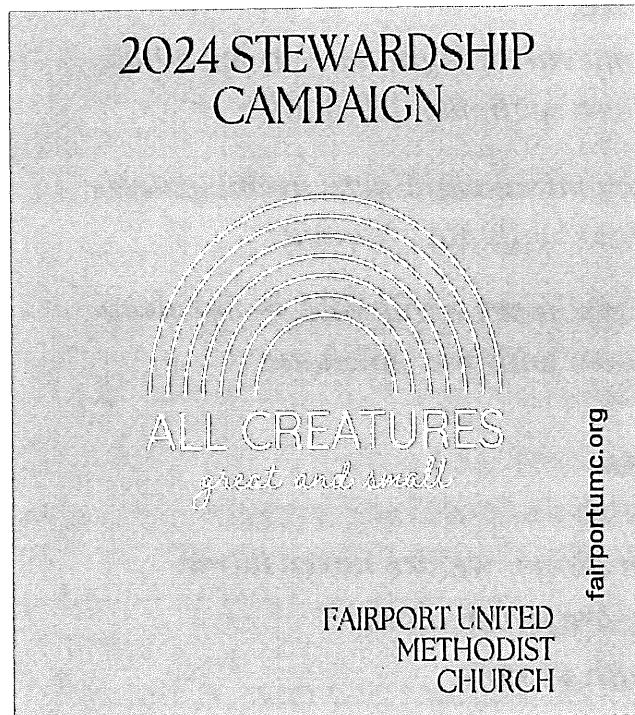
Apple Pie Sale 2024

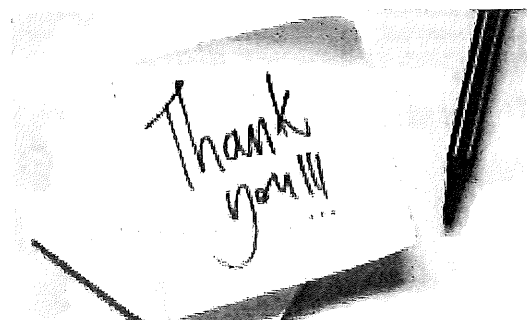
The Joy of Giving

Since Pledge Sunday we have received 58% of what we received all last year.

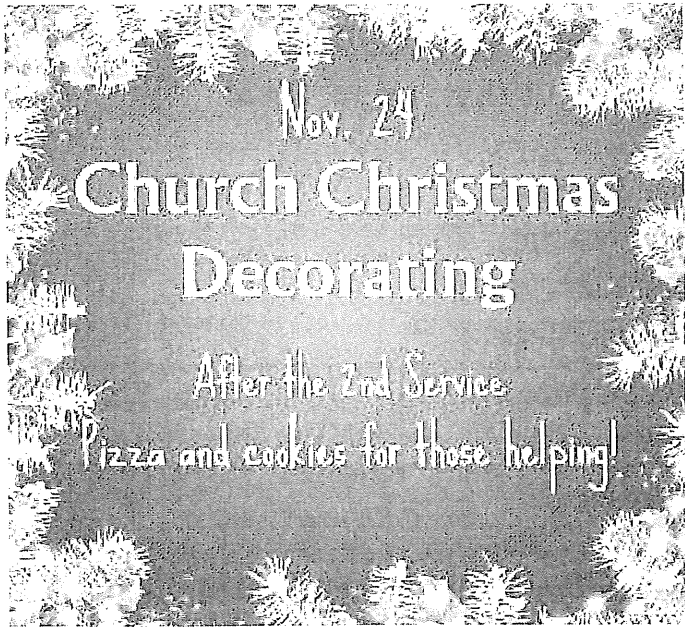
We feel optimistic that our Congregation will continue to pledge over the upcoming weeks and we will raise the financial resources we need to carry out our on-going mission for 2025.

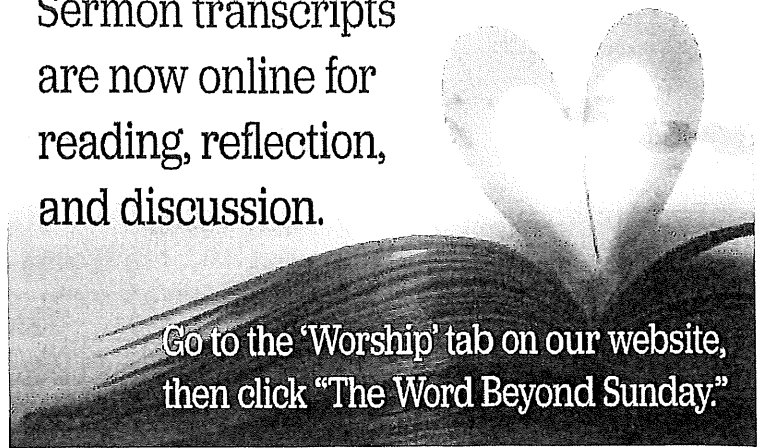
