Welcome to Fairport UMC! On communion Sundays we encourage you to retrieve you child and participate in communion together! Note: Sunday School (children/youth/adult) during the school year is at 9am.

OPEN TABLE

Communion is celebrated once a month (usually on the first Sunday of the month) and everyone (including children) is welcome at the table. We use gluten/dairy free bread and grape juice.





<u>Update on petition to keep NY State's</u> <u>commitment to Cut Child Poverty</u>

FUMC's Social Justice Team thanks all who signed the petition asking Gov Hochul to incorporate into the FY 2026 Executive Budget the policies urged by NYS's Child Poverty Reduction Advisory Council to cut the rate of child poverty in our state by 50% by 2032. The petition will be delivered to the Governor's Mansion this evening as part of a La Posada ("The Inn") procession, an event common in many hispanic cultures recalling Mary and Joseph's journey to Bethlehem.
