Welcome to Fairport UMC! On communion Sundays we encourage you to retrieve you child and participate in communion together!

Communion is celebrated once a month (usually on the first Sunday of the month) and everyone (including children) is welcome at the table. We use gluten/dairy free bread and grape juice.




We are looking to meet in Room 204 on a weeknight evening so that people can participate in-person or via Zoom.


