Communion is celebrated once a month (usually on the first Sunday of the month) and everyone (including children) is welcome at the table. We use gluten/dairy free bread and grape juice.

Come with rejoicing, lift up your voices, All Christians join in praise to the Lord. Blessing and honor be to the Savior, Angels on high sing praise to the Lord.



Special Sunday - Human Relations Day






Beyond These Walls Shelter Ministry - Sign up as a Volunteer or for Donations


